BACKGROUND

Usable items include furniture, clothing, building materials and kitchenware which are collected, refurbished, and resold, reducing waste and landfill tonnage. They also focus on responsible practices such as salvaging non-ferrous metals. Workshops and educational programs foster creativity and sustainable living. Repair services ensure broken items remain in use.

These solutions have been actively implemented by engaging the community, improving its operations, and expanding recycling and reusing activities. It collaborates with local partners, including the Shire of Denmark, and utilises its education centre to educate and empower the community.

RESULTS

The efforts have led to a significant reduction in landfill waste, promoting more sustainable waste management in Denmark. Community engagement is on the rise through educational programs and recycling activities. These actions have also resulted in tangible environmental benefits, including energy savings, and enhanced environmental efficiency.
